A.G. -v- Dean Gary Marie (Bail Application)

BAILIFF: "This is an application, of course, for a review of the discretion of the learned Assistant Magistrate when he refused one or more applications for bail from your client, Mr. Renouf. The learned Assistant Magistrate obviously has more details of the facts before him and he took the view that your client might well commit other offences. Having regard to what he actually did within 5 or 6 weeks of his release after serving a substantial prison sentence we think the Magistrate's fear was justified. We cannot find that there is anything in his decision which entitles us to review it and accordingly the application is refused.
