(Housing Infractions)

BAILIFF: We have had regard to what you have said Mr. Troy, that this is a case of foolishly trusting advice when they should have sought better advice, rather than grave dishonesty. Nevertheless, the Housing Law is there to be observed and they did take in the extra people and they did not occupy the rest of the house and they took out of circulation, one flat. Under the circumstances we are going to reduce the conclusions and your clients will be fined £500 each on charge 1 or 1 months' imprisonment and £350 each on count 2 or 3 weeks' imprisonment consecutive making total fines, between the two of them, of £1,700 and costs of £200.
