**JUDGMENT**

THE BAILIFF: You might well have endangered your own lives as well had the weather been somewhat different. You were fortunate not to suffer the risks which the sea has round these very dangerous coasts. Having looked at your records and having considered the offence we think that as far as you, DH, are concerned the conclusions are correct. Because of the restrictions of the Childrens' Law upon us we cannot sentence you in any way other than Borstal

training. As far as you are concerned, AC , you are younger than your co-accused and we think your youth entitles you to a little more mitigation than the Attorney General is prepared to give. We therefore sentence you to six months' imprisonment. We commend Mr. Hibb's for his initiative and we thank the French police for their help.
