PLEA:

Infraction admitted.

DETAILS OF OFFENCE:

Failure to make payment in respect of the "D" Quarter of 1991. Failed to respond to recorded delivery letters.

DETAILS OF MITIGATION:

Company in severe financial difficulty. Have established a creditor's fund and are endeavouring to keep all creditors on an equal footing despite aggravation from some of the said creditors.

CONCLUSIONS:

£750 fine with £250 costs.

SENTENCE AND OBSERVATIONS OF THE COURT:

£550 fine with £250 costs.

JUDGMENT

THE BAILLIFF: Given the company's difficulties over the last two years we think the appropriate figure is £550. The company is fined £550 with £250 costs.
