**The Brucevale Park, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern
Ireland) 2013**

Made - - - - - *6th June 2013*

Coming into operation - *11th September 2013*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1), (3) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that the road described in the Schedule is not necessary for vehicular traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Brucevale Park, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 11th September 2013.

Application

2.—(1) The road described in the Schedule shall be stopped-up to vehicular traffic at the line specified therein.

(2) The Department shall carry out such works as it considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as the Department thinks fit, access to the road described in the Schedule by vehicular traffic.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the road to be stopped-up shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.
