**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016**

Made - - - - - *28th September 2016*

Coming into operation - - - - - *24th October 2016*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 24th October 2016.

Amendment

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016^(d) shall be amended by the addition to Part 2 of Schedule 2 of the following items—

- “4. Rodgers Quay (north-east side) - from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with the A2, Belfast Road for a distance of 28 metres in a south-easterly direction.
5. Rodgers Quay (south-west side) - from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with the A2, Belfast Road for a distance of 52 metres in a south-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 (“the Order”) by the addition of a ‘no waiting at any time’ restriction on the lengths of road specified in Article 2.

Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
