**The Traffic Weight Restriction (Amendment) Order (Northern  
Ireland) 2017**

*Made* - - - - - *1st June 2017*

*Coming into operation* - *22nd June 2017*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Traffic Weight Restriction (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 and shall come into operation on 22nd June 2017.

**Amendment**

2. The Traffic Weight Restriction Order (Northern Ireland) 2004<sup>(d)</sup> is amended by the addition of the following item to Schedule 3—

“100. Aghaloo Road, Unclassified No. 0321, Ballygawley.”

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Traffic Weight Restriction Order (Northern Ireland) 2004 (“the Order”) by the addition of Aghaloo Road, Ballygawley to Schedule 3. Vehicles requiring access are excepted from the provisions of the Order.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 (“the Regulation Order”) and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000), in accordance with the Road Traffic Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 as amended by the Regulation Order.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
