The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Magherafelt) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022

Coming into operation - 15th November 2022

The Department for Infrastructure(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Magherafelt) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022 and shall come into operation on 15th November 2022.

Amendment

- **2.** The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Magherafelt) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018(**d**) is amended by the addition to Part 1 of Schedule 2 of the following item—
 - "37. Mullaghboy Crescent (north-east side) from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Mullaghboy Lane for a distance of 17.5 metres in a south-easterly direction."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Magherafelt) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 ("the Order") by the addition to Part 1 of Schedule 2 of the item specified in Article 2.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
