ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

The Prohibition of Traffic (Lay-by on Glenshane Road, Route A6, Maghera) Order (Northern Ireland) 2023

Made - - - - 13th December 2023

Coming into operation 8th January 2024

The Department for Infrastructure(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with Article 4(6) and paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Prohibition of Traffic (Lay-by on Glenshane Road, Route A6, Maghera) Order (Northern Ireland) 2023 and shall come into operation on 8th January 2024.

Application

2. This Order shall have effect as if map no. INI/23/190864 were part of the Order.

Prohibition

3. A person shall not, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 in the direction specified in Column 2.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits vehicles exiting Glenshane Road from entering the western entrance to the lay-by opposite the junction of Glenshane Road and Ranaghan Road.

Any person who acts in contravention of this Order shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 ("the Regulation Order") and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000) in accordance with the Road Traffic Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 as amended by the Regulation Order.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
