ROAD TRAFFIC

The South East Unit Trunk Roads Area (Temporary Prohibitions of Traffic, Temporary Prohibitions of Overtaking and Temporary Speed Restrictions) (No. 9) Order 2010

Made

17th September 2010

Coming into force

1st October 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1), 14(1) and (4), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the South East Unit Trunk Roads Area (Temporary Prohibitions of Traffic, Temporary Prohibitions of Overtaking and Temporary Speed Restrictions) (No. 9) Order 2010, comes into force on 1st October 2010 and ceases to have effect at 0001 hours on 1st January 2011.

Interpretation

2. In this Order a reference to a numbered column is to the column in the Schedule bearing that number.

Temporary prohibition on use of a road

3. Subject to article 6, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on each length of road specified in column 1 when a prohibition is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002^(b).

Temporary prohibition on overtaking

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other moving vehicle on each length of road specified in column 1 when a prohibition is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 632 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) shall prohibit any person from using, or permitting the use of, any vehicle in such a way that it overtakes a cycle, motor cycle, tricycle or any other vehicle not being a motor vehicle in accordance with section 140 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a).

Temporary speed restriction

5.No person shall drive any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Part 2 of the Schedule at a speed exceeding that specified in column 2 when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

6. Article 3 does not apply to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes or a vehicle while being used for carrying out the works.

1. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road being the southbound off slip road at Junction 5 (Grangemouth), a distance of 250 metres or thereby.
2. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh – Stirling – Thurso Trunk Road being the northbound on slip road at Junction 9 (Bannockburn), a distance of 680 metres or thereby.
3. That length of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road being the southbound on slip road at Junction 1 (Checkbar), a distance of 520 metres or thereby.
4. That length of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road being the eastbound slip road from the M9 at Junction 7 (Kinnaird House), a distance of 1.1 kilometres or thereby.
5. That length of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road being the northbound combined on and off slip roads at Junction 1 (Checkbar), a distance of 200 metres or thereby.
6. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound off slip road at Junction 5 (Shotts), a distance of 460 metres or thereby.
7. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound on slip road at Junction 5 (Shotts), a distance of 530 metres or thereby.
8. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound on slip road at Junction 5 (Shotts), a distance of 590 metres or thereby.
9. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound on slip road at Junction 4 (Whitburn), a distance of 400 metres or thereby.
10. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound combined on/off slip road at Chapelhall Junction, a distance of 340 metres or thereby.
11. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound combined on/off slip road at Chapelhall Junction, a distance of 180 metres or thereby.
12. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 470 metres or thereby.
13. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound on slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 525 metres or thereby.
14. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound off slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 565 metres or thereby.
15. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound on slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 465 metres or thereby.
16. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound combined on/off slip road at Shawhead Junction, a distance of 360 metres or thereby.
17. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound combined on/off slip road at Shawhead Junction, a distance of 400 metres or thereby.
18. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off slip road (dedicated to the A725 southbound) at Shawhead Junction, a distance of 280 metres or thereby.
19. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound combined on/off slip road at Bargeddie Junction, a distance of 200 metres or thereby.
20. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound combined on/off slip road at Bargeddie Junction, a distance of 190 metres or thereby.
21. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off

slip road at Baillieston Junction, a distance of 375 metres or thereby.
22. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound on slip road at Baillieston Junction, a distance of 315 metres or thereby.

23. That length of the A1 Edinburgh - Berwick Upon Tweed Trunk Road being the southbound carriageway from Thistly Cross Roundabout to Spott Roundabout, a distance of 3 kilometres or thereby.	40mph
24. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh – Stirling – Thurso Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageways from the northbound off slip road at Junction 1A (Kirkliston) to the northbound on slip road at Junction 10 (Craigforth), a distance of 44.6 kilometres or thereby.	40 mph
25. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageways from the southbound off slip road at Junction 5 to the southbound on slip road at Junction 4, a distance of 5.7 kilometres or thereby.	40 mph
26. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageways from the southbound off slip road at Junction 10 to New Line Road over bridge, a distance of 6.3 kilometres or thereby.	40 mph
