JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. The Tribunal attempted to make contact with the Claimant on numerous occasions in the e-mails dated 07 February 2017, 29 March 2017 and 18 April 2017. The Claimant did not respond to these communications.
2. On 09 May 2017 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 17 May 2017 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
3. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
