JUDGMENT

1. The claim against the second respondent, Interdoor Limited, is **DISMISSED** on withdrawal.
2. By consent the claim for unlawful deduction from wages **SUCCEEDS** against the first respondent, Envirodoor Limited, and the first respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £1500 gross. This is a gross amount and the respondent is responsible for deducting and accounting for any amount of national insurance or tax due thereon.
3. By consent the claim for unlawful deductions from wages (holiday pay) **SUCCEEDS** against the first respondent, Envirodoor Limited, and by consent the first respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £310.50 gross. This is a gross amount and the respondent is responsible for deducting and accounting for any amount of national insurance or tax due thereon.
