JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim against the second respondent, Interdoor Limited, is **DISMISSED** on withdrawal.
- 2. By consent the claim for unlawful deduction from wages **SUCCEEDS** against the first respondent, Envirodoor Limited, and the first respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £1500 gross. This is a gross amount and the respondent is responsible for deducting and accounting for any amount of national insurance or tax due thereon.
- 3. By consent the claim for unlawful deductions from wages (holiday pay) **SUCCEEDS** against the first respondent, Envirodoor Limited, and by consent the first respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £310.50 gross. This is a gross amount and the respondent is responsible for deducting and accounting for any amount of national insurance or tax due thereon.
