JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgement of the Tribunal is:-

- 1. The claim of unfair dismissal is ill founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The claim of discrimination arising from a disability is ill founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The claim of a failure to make a reasonable adjustments (adjusting the claimant's duties and work load, and failing to obtain in house counselling for the claimant) have been brought out of time. It would not be just and equitable to extend time. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear this claim.

4. The claim of harassment is out of time and the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the claim.
