## **PATENTS ACT 1977**

IN THE MATTER OF an application under Section 13(1) by Damian Davies in respect of Patent Number GB 2359924 in the name of Loughborough University Innovations Ltd

## **DECISION**

- Patent number GB 2359924 was granted pursuant to the international phase of international patent application number PCT/GB00/02591 filed in the name of Loughborough University Innovations Ltd. In the original PCT application, the inventors were named as: Stuart James Rowen, Mark Christopher Turpin and Paul Leonard Adcock.
- Damian Davies has applied to be mentioned as a joint inventor in accordance with Section 13(1) of the Act.
- In a letter dated 18 December 2001, Phillips & Leigh, the agents for the patent proprietors confirmed that Loughborough University Innovations Limited consented to Damian Davies' application under section 13(1). Stuart James Rowen, Mark Christopher Turpin and Paul Leonard Adcock have each confirmed in writing that they support the addition of Damian Davies as a joint inventor. I therefore conclude that the relevant parties agree that Damian Davies was a joint inventor.
- Accordingly I find that Damian Davies should be mentioned as a joint inventor in the granted patent. I also direct in accordance with Rule 14(5) that an addendum slip mentioning him as a joint inventor be prepared for the granted patent.
