This is an appeal from an order of the Court of Appeal of Jamaica dated 30th October 1984. By that order the Court dismissed the appellant's appeal from an order of the Disciplinary Committee of the General Legal Council dated 8th May 1982 finding him guilty of professional misconduct as a barrister and solicitor. The effect of the Disciplinary Committee's order was that the appellant should be reprimanded and that he should pay by way of restitution to the Alpart Credit Union the sum of \$4,880.49.

Mr. Macaulay has said all that could possibly be said on behalf of the appellant against the decision of the Court of Appeal. But their Lordships are satisfied that in all respects the Court of Appeal came to the right conclusion and they will therefore humbly advise Her Majesty that this appeal should be dismissed with costs.
