



CHAPTER 22.

An Act to amend the designation of the Assessor of A.D. 1934. Railways and Canals in Scotland and the law relating to the appointment of the said assessor and the provision of superannuation allowances for the said assessor and the clerks and other officers employed by him. [22nd June 1934.]

DE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

All superannuation allowances and gratuities to be granted under the provisions of this Act and any superannuation allowance granted under the Railway Assessors (Scotland) Superannuation Act, 1897, shall be levied and collected along with and in the same manner as the remuneration or salary of the assessor and his clerks and other officers, as prescribed in section twentynine of the Lands Valuation (Scotland) Act, 1854.
- Repeal. 4. The Railway Assessors (Scotland) Superannuation Act, 1897, is hereby repealed.
- Short title. 5. This Act may be cited as the Assessor of Public Undertakings (Scotland) Act, 1934.
