ROAD TRAFFIC

The M4 Motorway (Junction 11) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 Variation Order 2010

Made - - - - - *6th September 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *11th September 2010*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) and (7) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):-

1. This Order may be cited as the M4 Motorway (Junction 11) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 Variation Order 2010 and shall come into force on 11th September 2010.

2. The M4 Motorway (Junction 11) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010(b) is hereby varied -

(a) by substituting, for the definition of “a first period” in article 2 of that Order, the following definition -

““a first period” means a period of 24 hours starting at 0001 hours on Sunday 11th April 2010 or on any subsequent day until 10th November 2010;” and

(b) by substituting, for the definition of “a second period” in article 2 of that Order, the following definition -

““a second period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Sunday 11th April 2010 or on any subsequent day until 10th November 2010;”.
