**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A63 Trunk Road (Market Place to Garrison Road Roundabout)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *4th April 2011*  
*Coming into force* - *16th April 2011*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road, and connecting roads, in the District of Kingston upon Hull, is satisfied that traffic and pedestrians on that trunk road and one of those connecting roads should be prohibited because bridge maintenance and repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (Market Place to Garrison Road Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 16th April 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 8 hours starting at 06:00 hours on Sunday 17th April 2011 or any subsequent Sunday thereafter until the said works have been completed:

- (a) cause or permit any traffic to enter or proceed in the A63 Trunk Road:
  - (i) eastbound and westbound carriageways between their junctions with Market Place and their junctions with Garrison Road Roundabout, a distance of 800 metres;
  - (ii) westbound carriageway between the nose of the westbound exit slip road leading to Alexandra Dock and its junction with Garrison Road Roundabout, a distance of 940 metres; and
  - (iii) westbound entry slip road at Mount Pleasant Roundabout; or
- (b) enter or proceed in the A63 Trunk Road between its junction with Market Place and the easternmost limit of Myton Bridge; and
- (c) cause or permit any vehicle to enter the A63 at its side road leading to Market Place.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
