ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1 Trunk Road and the A1(M) Motorway (A1(M) Junction
1 – Rowley Lane, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *18th April 2011*

Coming into force - - *7th May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of those roads and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road and the A1(M) Motorway (A1(M) Junction 1 – Rowley Lane, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th May 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the A1” and “the A1(M)” mean, respectively, the A1 Trunk Road and the A1(M) Motorway west of Potters Bar in the County of Hertfordshire;

“the length of carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the A1(M) and the A1 between the southbound exit slip road (at marker post 25/0) at Junction 1 (M25 Junction 23) and the southbound exit slip road (at marker post 19/4) at Rowley Lane Interchange (A5135);

“the slip road” means the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A1 from the roundabout at Junction 1 (M25 Junction 23/A1001);

“the side road” means Trotters Bottom and Galley Lane at their junction with the southbound carriageway of the A1;

“works” mean resurfacing, road marking and road stud installation works on the A1 and the A1(M); and

“a works period” means a period of 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 9th May 2011 or on any subsequent day until 6th November 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (a) to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway or the slip road; or
- (b) to enter the side road from the A1 or to enter the A1 from the side road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of carriageway or the slip road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that carriageway or that slip road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
