**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A69 Trunk Road (Horsley Junction) (Temporary Restriction  
and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *28th April 2011*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *8th May 2011*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A69 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the County of Northumberland, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be restricted and prohibited because carriageway resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A69 Trunk Road (Horsley Junction) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 8th May 2011.

**2.** In this Order; –

“the A69” means the A69 Trunk Road;

“the eastbound carriageway” and “the westbound carriageway” mean, respectively, the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A69 from a point 1500 metres east of the centreline of Horsley Junction westwards for a distance of 2000 metres;

“the slip roads” means any of the following A69 slip roads:

- (i) the eastbound entry slip road at Horsley Junction; and
- (ii) the westbound exit slip road at Horsley Junction;

“the works period” means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on Monday 9th May 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the eastbound carriageway or the westbound carriageway.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

**5.** Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake another moving vehicle in the eastbound carriageway or the westbound carriageway.

**6.** The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in articles 4 and 5 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.
