ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A5036 Trunk Road
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) (No 2) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *27th April 2011*
Coming into force - - - - - *2nd May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5036 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road in the District of Sefton in Merseyside should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5036 Trunk Road (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) (No 2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd May 2011.

2. In this Order;

“the trunk road” means the A5036 Trunk Road;

“works” means gas mains refurbishment works on the trunk road;

“the length of trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the trunk road from the centreline of the junction of the trunk road with Copy Lane, to the centreline of the junction of the trunk road with Park Lane West;

“the works period” means a period starting at 2100 hours on Tuesday 3 May 2011 and ending at 0500 hours on Saturday 16 July 2011. Works may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of trunk road at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.

5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
