ROAD TRAFFIC

The A23 Trunk Road (Hickstead Interchange – Pyecombe Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *3rd May 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *21st May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A23 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A23 Trunk Road (Hickstead Interchange – Pyecombe Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 21st May 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A23 Trunk Road in the County of West Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between Hickstead Interchange (A2300) and Pyecombe Interchange (A273 – Clayton Hill);

“works” mean road marking work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 23rd May 2011 or on any subsequent day until 20th November 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
