ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M6 Toll Motorway (Junction T2 to M6 Junction 3a) and the
M42 Motorway (Junction 9 to Junction 8) (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic Order 2011**

Made - - - - 9th May 2011

Coming into force - - 16th May 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway (“the M42”), the M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those motorways and one of those connecting roads in the County of Warwickshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Toll Motorway (Junction T2 to M6 Junction 3a) and the M42 Motorway (Junction 9 to Junction 8) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 16th May 2011.

2. In this Order -

“the motorway”

means –

- (i) the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction T2 to its junction with the southbound carriageway of the M6 at junction 3a; and
- (ii) the southbound carriageway of the M42 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 9 to its junction with the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 8 of the M42;

“the slip road”

means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 9;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

"the works period"

means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Saturday 21st May 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer.
