ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth,
Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians)
Order 2011**

Made - - - - *24th May 2011*

Coming into force - - *31st May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Great Yarmouth in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st May 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A12 between its junctions with the A12/A47 Acle New Road Roundabout and the A12/A1243 Gapton Hall/Pasteur Road Roundabout, Great Yarmouth;

“bicycle” means a pedal cycle with fewer than four wheels and not being a mechanically propelled vehicle;

“works” mean annual routine maintenance work to Breydon Bridge;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 7 June 2011 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, during a works period, no –

- (a) person shall cause or permit any vehicle to, or
- (b) pedestrian, or person using a bicycle shall,

enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle -

- (a) being used in connection with, or for, the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) proceeding to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.

6. During a works period, the provisions of The A47 Trunk Road (Great Yarmouth Western Bypass) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 1988(a) are hereby suspended.
