ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (North of Coventry) (Closure of Gap in the Central Reservation) Order 2011

Made - - - - 13th May 2011

Coming into force - - 27th May 2011

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (North of Coventry) (Closure of Gap in the Central Reservation) Order 2011 and comes into force on 27th May 2011.

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” means the A46 Trunk Road southeast of Junction 2 of the M6 motorway, north of Coventry in the County of Warwickshire;

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the A46, the A4600 Hinckley Road and the slip roads leading to and from the M6 (Junction 2), and

“central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road approximately 275 metres southeast of the roundabout.
