**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A11 Trunk Road (B1172/B1135 Wymondham Interchange to A47/B1172 Cringleford Interchange, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *6th June 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *13th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A11 Trunk Road (“the A11”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A11 Trunk Road (B1172/B1135 Wymondham Interchange to A47/B1172 Cringleford Interchange, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 13th June 2011.

2. In this Order -

“the trunk road” means the A11 between its junctions with the B1172/B1135 Wymondham Interchange and the A47/B1172 Cringleford Interchange;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in the trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean improvement works being carried out to overhead power lines;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Saturday –

- (a) 18th June 2011,
- (b) 2nd July 2011,
- (c) 24th September 2011, and
- (d) 8th October 2011;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes or any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
