ROAD TRAFFIC

The A50 Trunk Road (Hilton to Foston, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *6th June 2011*

Coming into force - - *13th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads between Hilton and Foston in the County of Derbyshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Hilton to Foston, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 13th June 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A516 at Hilton to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A511 at Foston;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A516;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 17th June 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
