**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *6th June 2011*

*Coming into force* - - *13th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Blythe Bridge in the County of Staffordshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 13th June 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –

- a) the westbound carriageway of A50 from its roundabout junction with the A521 at Blythe Bridge to its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the A521 and Lysander Road at Meir; and
- b) the eastbound carriageway of A50 from its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout junction with the A521 and Lysander Road at Meir to its roundabout junction with the A521 at Blythe Bridge;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 20th June 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
