ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Ardleigh, Essex) Southbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 20th June 2011

Coming into force - - 27th June 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Ardleigh, Essex) Southbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th June 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 8 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 4th July 2011, or on any subsequent day until resurfacing, road marking, litter picking, sweeping, sign cleaning, gully emptying, weed spraying, grass cutting and structural inspection works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the southbound exit slip road of the A12 leading to Old Ipswich Road (Jubilee Café), Ardleigh.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works.
