**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 7 Stevenage, Hertfordshire)
Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *27th June 2011*

Coming into force - - *4th July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway (“the A1(M)”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads at Stevenage in the District of North Hertfordshire in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 7 Stevenage, Hertfordshire) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th July 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 06.00 hours on Thursday 7th July 2011 and ending at 12.00 hours on Monday 11th July 2011 when the likelihood of danger to the public has ceased, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound entry or southbound exit slip roads of the A1(M) at Junction 7.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
