**The A1 Trunk Road (East Ord Roundabout to Duns Road)
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *14th July 2011*

Coming into force - - *24th July 2011*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road, in the County of Northumberland, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because carriageway resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (East Ord Roundabout to Duns Road) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 24th July 2011.

2. In this Order; -

“the A1” means the A1 Trunk Road from its junction with East Ord Roundabout to the centreline of its junction with the B6461, a distance of 2400 metres;

“a layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the A1 Trunk Road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the central reservation” means that part of the A1 Trunk Road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of traffic using that road;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 25th July 2011 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the A1.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation opposite the A6105 Duns Road.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in a layby situated adjacent to the A1 Trunk Road approximately 285 metres south of its junction with the A6105 Duns Road.

6. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A1 Trunk Road at its junctions with the A6105 Duns Road.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in articles 4, 5 and 6 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.

8. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
