ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (West of Stratford-upon-Avon,
Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of
Traffic) (No.2) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *18th July 2011*
Coming into force - - *25th July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Stratford-upon-Avon in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (West of Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 25th July 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A46 between its roundabout junction with the A422 (Shottery Roundabout) and a point 3090 metres west of that roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 08.00 hours on Monday 1st August 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

(b) 40 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst such traffic signs in relation to those lengths are not displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake a moving vehicle on the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to make a U turn in the trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

(a) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle-

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

(b) article 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
