**The M62 Motorway (Junction 28, Junction 31 and Junction 32)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - 22nd July 2011

Coming into force - 31st July 2011

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the Districts of Leeds and Wakefield in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 28, Junction 31 and Junction 32) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st July 2011.

2. In this Order; –

“the M62” means the M62 Motorway;

“the westbound carriageway” means the M62 westbound carriageway between the noses of the westbound exit and entry slip roads at Junction 28 (Tingley), a distance of 600 metres;

“a slip road” means any of the following M62 slip roads:

- (i) the westbound entry slip road at Junction 28;
- (ii) the eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 31 (Normanton); and
- (iii) the westbound exit slip road Junction 32 (Castleford);

“the first works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 1st August 2011 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday nights thereafter until the said works have been completed;

“the second works period” means a period of 13 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 5th August 2011 or any subsequent Friday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

“the third works period” means a period of 15 hours starting at 19:00 hours on Saturday 6th August 2011 or any subsequent Saturday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the first works period, the second works period or the third works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the westbound carriageway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
