**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London
Remembrance Events) Regulations 2011**

Made - - - - - *27th July 2011*

Coming into force - - - *12th November 2011*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of the Royal Albert Hall and Charing Cross, London during the Remembrance Day events scheduled to take place on 12th and 13th November 2011.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London Remembrance Events) Regulations 2011 and come into force on 12th November 2011.

2. In regulations 3 and 4 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

3. Subject to regulation 4—

- (a) between 1800 hours and 2300 hours on 12th November 2011 no aircraft is to fly below 2,000 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 2.5 nautical miles whose centre is 513005N 0001038W; and
- (b) between 1030 hours and 1200 hours on 13th November 2011 no aircraft is to fly below 2,000 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 2.5 nautical miles whose centre is 513030N 0000731W.

4. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of regulation 3 do not apply to any aircraft—

- (a) operated by the Metropolitan Police Service;
- (b) operated by the Helicopter Emergency Medical Services; or
- (c) making an approach to Runway 10 at London City Airport at a height of not less than 1,500 feet above mean sea level and to the east of a line running true north to true south through 513030N 0000514W (London Bridge).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations restrict flying in the vicinity of Royal Albert Hall by reason of the Royal British Legion Festival of Remembrance to be held on 12th November 2011 (regulation 3(a)) and by reason of the Remembrance Sunday Ceremony at the Cenotaph on 13th November 2011 (regulation 3(b)). The Home Office, on behalf of the Metropolitan Police, has requested these restrictions, which form part of the overall security arrangements for the Remembrance events in London. This request has been agreed with the Civil Aviation Authority and Department for Transport.

Full details of this Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
