ROAD TRAFFIC

The A27 Trunk Road (Crockhurst Hill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *8th August 2011*
Coming into force - - *27th August 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Crockhurst Hill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th August 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road (Crockhurst Hill) near Worthing in the County of West Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the A27 (Crockhurst Hill) between Offington Corner roundabout (A24 Warren Road/Findon Road/A2031 Offington Lane) and a point 50 metres south of its junction with Mill Lane;

“Half Moon Lane” means the road known as Half Moon Lane at its junction with the trunk road;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, road marking and road stud replacement work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 9½ hours starting at 1930 hours on Tuesday 30th August 2011 or on any subsequent day until 26th February 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (a) to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road; or
- (b) to enter the trunk road from Half Moon Lane or to enter Half Moon Lane from the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
