ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M1 Motorway (Junction 8, Hertfordshire) Southbound
Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *8th August 2011*
Coming into force - - *15th August 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 8, Hertfordshire) Southbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 15th August 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 18th August 2011, or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until works to install traffic signs, road markings and studs have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the M1 southbound entry slip road at Junction 8 leading from the A414 Hemel Hempstead.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic office purposes.
