ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 Trunk Road (M42 Junction 6 to Stonebridge Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *1st August 2011*
Coming into force - - *8th August 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and two of those connecting roads, in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull and the County of Warwickshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (M42 Junction 6 to Stonebridge Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 8th August 2011.

2. In this Order:

| “the roundabout” | means the A45/M42 Junction 6 roundabout junction; |
| “Stonebridge roundabout” | means the A45/A452 roundabout junction; |
| “the trunk road” | means – |
| | (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout, to its junction with the slip road leading from Stonebridge Roundabout; and |
| | (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with the slip road leading to Stonebridge Roundabout, to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout; |

“a slip road”

means –

(i) the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A45 from the roundabout, from its junction with Middle Bickenhill Lane to its junction with the eastbound carriageway of the A45; and

(ii) the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A45 from Stonebridge Roundabout;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 15th August 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
