ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A63 Trunk Road (Mytongate Gyratory to Market Place)
(Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *31st August 2011*

Coming into force - *4th September 2011*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Kingston upon Hull, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted because traffic signal renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (Mytongate Gyratory to Market Place) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th September 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 5th September 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the A63 Trunk Road:

- (i) eastbound carriageway from its junction with the A1079 Mytongate Gyratory to its junction with Market Place, a distance of 590 metres; or
- (ii) westbound carriageway from its junction with Queens Street to its junction with Mytongate Gyratory, a distance of 590 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
