**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A500 Trunk Road (M6 Junction 16 to Talke Roundabout,  
Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *2nd September 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *9th September 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road (“the A500”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Newcastle under Lyme in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (M6 Junction 16 to Talke Roundabout, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 9th September 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A500 from its roundabout junction with the M6 at Junction 16 to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A34 (Talke Roundabout);

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 12th September 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used for or in connection with the said works.
