**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - 21st January 2011

*Coming into force* - - 31st January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Wanlip in the County of Leicestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st January 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A6 (Wanlip Roundabout), to its roundabout junction with the A607 (Hobby Horse Roundabout);

“the works period” means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 31 January 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
