ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A36 Trunk Road (Wylve Junction to Wilton Roundabout,
Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *26th October 2011*

Coming into force - - - *4th November 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads between the Wylve Junction and the Wilton Roundabout, Salisbury, in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Wylve Junction to Wilton Roundabout, Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th November 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means the A36 from a point 1000 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A303 at Wylve to the western edge of Wilton Roundabout, Salisbury;

“the slip road” means the A303 westbound exit slip road to the A36 at the Deptford / Wylve Junction;

“the works” mean carriageway white lining, patching and stud replacement works;

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Sunday 6th November 2011 or any subsequent night and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A36 or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works;
- (d) vehicles proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.
