

in the offside lane of the southbound carriageway or the offside lane of the northbound carriageway.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during –
- (a) a first works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway, the northbound carriageway or a slip road when that speed is indicated by a traffic sign;
 - (b) a first works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 60 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway or the northbound carriageway when that speed is indicated by a traffic sign; or
 - (c) a second works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway or the northbound carriageway while traffic signs authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act indicating “convoy working” on that carriageway are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -
- (a) a recovery vehicle or a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform;
 - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
 - (e) an abnormal load.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
