ROAD TRAFFIC

The A52 Trunk Road (Nottingham) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *25th November 2011*

Coming into force - - *2nd December 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on three of those connecting roads, in the City of Nottingham, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Nottingham) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd December 2011.

2. In this Order:

“a slip road” means the slip road –

- (a) leading from the A52 westbound carriageway to its roundabout junction with the A6005 at Dunkirk;
- (b) leading to the A52 eastbound carriageway from its roundabout junction with the A6005 at Dunkirk; and
- (c) leading to the A52 northbound carriageway from its roundabout junction with the A453 (Queens Drive Roundabout).

“the works period” means the period starting at 22:30 hours on Saturday 3rd December 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
