ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 Trunk Road (Northampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *30th December 2011*

Coming into force - - *6th January 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Northampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th January 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –

- i) the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A428 (Barnes Meadow Interchange) to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with Eagle Drive and Caswell Road (Brackmills Interchange); and
- ii) the eastbound carriageway of the A45 between its junctions with the slip roads leading to and from its roundabout junction with Eagle Drive and Caswell Road (Brackmills Interchange);

“the works period” means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 9th January 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
