ROAD TRAFFIC

The A2 Trunk Road (Dover Road) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *21st February 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *12th March 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Dover Road) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A2 Trunk Road (Dover Road) southeast of Canterbury in the County of Kent;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 250 metres northwest of the Londonbound ‘off’ slip road to Bishopsbourne and 150 metres northwest of the A260 overbridge near Barham;

“works” means drainage work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Wednesday 16th March 2011 or on any subsequent day until 11th September 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
