**The A11 Trunk Road (Station Lane, Ketteringham, Norfolk)
(Closure of Gaps in the Central Reservation) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *18th February 2011*

Coming into force - - *4th March 2011*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the A11 Trunk Road (Station Lane, Ketteringham, Norfolk) (Closure of Gaps in the Central Reservation) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th March 2011.

2. In this Order -

“the trunk road” means the A11 Trunk Road in the District of South Norfolk in the County of Norfolk;

“central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates the carriageway to be used by vehicles travelling in one direction from the carriageway to be used by vehicles travelling in the opposite direction;

and a reference to a junction with a road is a reference to the junction of the trunk road with that road.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation opposite the junction of the trunk road with the C182 Station Lane leading to -

- (a) Ketteringham, or
- (b) Hethersett.
