ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A23 Trunk Road (M23 Junction 11, Slip Road)
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *28th February 2011*

Coming into force - - *19th March 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A23 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A23 Trunk Road (M23 Junction 11, Slip Road) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 19th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A23 Trunk Road near Crawley in the County of West Sussex;

“the slip road” means the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road to the roundabout at M23 Junction 11 (A264);

“works” means expansion joint repair work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Wednesday 23rd March 2011 or on any subsequent day until 18th September 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
