# The North Devon (Electoral Changes) Order 2012

Made - - - - 4th April 2012

Coming into force in accordance with article 2

Under section 92(2) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007(a) ("the 2007 Act") North Devon District Council made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England(b) for the related alteration of the boundaries of district wards within the Council's area.

The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has decided to give effect to the recommendations and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 92(3) of the 2007 Act makes the following Order:

#### Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the North Devon (Electoral Changes) Order 2012.

#### Commencement

- 2. This Order comes into force—
  - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of councillors for district wards, on 15th October 2014;
  - (b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015 as defined by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983(c).

#### Interpretation

3. In this Order—

"district ward" means a ward established by the District of North Devon (Electoral Changes) Order  $1999(\mathbf{d})$  and the North Devon (Parish Electoral Arrangements and Electoral Changes) Order  $2007(\mathbf{e})$ .

#### Related alterations of district ward boundaries

**4.** The area that ceased to be part of the parish of Swimbridge and became part of the parish of Chittlehampton in consequence of the North Devon District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) No. 1 Order 2011(a) ceases to be part of Landkey, Swimbridge and Taw district ward and becomes part of Chittlehampton district ward.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by North Devon District Council to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by the North Devon District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) No. 1 Order 2011.

The new boundaries apply in respect of district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

Article 4 alters the boundaries of Landkey, Swimbridge and Taw and Chittlehampton district wards.

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.
