The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Elgin Offshore Installation) (Amendment No 2) Regulations 2012

Made - - - - at 17.38 hours on 30th March 2012

Coming into force - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has deemed it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of the area specified in the Schedule to the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Elgin offshore installation) Regulations 2012^(a) (“the principal Regulations”) by reason of an emergency having arisen in that area.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(b).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Elgin Offshore Installation) (Amendment No 2) Regulations 2012 and come into force with immediate effect.

2.—(1) The principal Regulations are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3, delete “ARCC or Aberdeen air traffic control” and replace with the “Total Emergency Response Team Duty Safety Officer.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the instrument which imposed emergency restrictions on flying in the area specified in the Schedule to that instrument by replacing the ARCC and Aberdeen air traffic control as the directing authority with The Total Emergency Response Team Duty Safety Officer to regulation 3.
